Comes now Petitioner Raymond G. Farmer, as Liquidator of the above-captioned insurance company (First Keystone), by and through the undersigned counsel, files herewith his Third Claims Report and applies to the Court for an Order approving the Liquidator's undisputed claim determinations specified herein.

This application is made pursuant to the South Carolina Insurers Rehabilitation and Liquidation Act, S.C. Code Ann. §§ 38-27-10 et seq., specifically, S.C. Code Ann. § 38-27-620(a) (2015), wherein the Liquidator is required to review all claims duly filed in the liquidation proceedings, make such turther investigation as he deems necessary, and submit a claims report to the Court containing his claim recommendations.

In support of his report, recommendation, and application the Liquidator would respectfully show the following:

1. Between the entry of the Order of Liquidation on October 21, 2014 and February 28, 2015, the latter being the Claims Bar Date, the Liquidator issued approximately five thousand and seven hundred (5,700) Notices of Liquidation and Proof of Claim (POC) forms, with

instructions to policyholders, third-party claimants and other potential claimants and/or creditors of First Keystone,

- 2. On November 3, 2014, notice of the liquidation was published in the Philadelphia Daily News, a newspaper of countywide circulation in the County of Philadelphia, informing interested parties of the liquidation proceedings and including contact information and instructions for the timely filing of a claim.
- 3. On or before the Bar Date of February 28, 2015, the Liquidator received one thousand six hundred and ninety-two (1,692) timely-filed POCs. The Liquidator also received one-hundred and twenty-four (124) late-filed claims, twenty-two (22) of which have now been deemed timely filed, with the remaining one-hundred and two (102) pending review.
- 4. Eight-hundred and thirty-one (831) claims have previously been adjudicated and submitted to the Court for approval, with such approval granted by orders entered March 24, 2017 and July 24, 2017.
- 5. One-hundred and thirty-one (131) more claims have now been adjudicated and are hereby submitted these claims to the Court for approval.
- 6. All remaining POCs received, totaling eight-hundred and fifty-four (854), remain under evaluation. Determinations, once concluded, will be forwarded to these remaining claimants via first class or certified mail.
- 7. Attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein is a schedule listing the names and addresses of these one-hundred and thirty-one (131) claimants holding a priority class 2 claim as defined by S.C. Code Ann. § 38-27-610(2) (2015), the POC number assigned by the Liquidator and the Liquidator's valuation recommendation for each of these class 2 claims.
 - 8. Additionally, the Liquidator at this time proposes and recommends to the Court that

in order to prevent prejudice to the proceedings or the waste of assets and to ensure the orderly administration and timely closing of this liquidation, any POC filed on or after the date of the submission of this Application be deemed denied and forever barred.

9. In further support of this report, recommendation and application, the Liquidator has attached as Exhibit B, the affidavit of Michael J. FitzGibbons, Special Deputy Liquidator.

WHEREFORE, the Liquidator prays the Court issue an Order approving this Third Claims Report and claim recommendations, with the actual distribution to be determined at the appropriate time in accordance with S.C. Code Ann. §§ 38-27-610 & -630 (2015), as well as such other relief as the Court deems just and proper.

Michael J. FitzGibbons, being first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

- 1. I am the Special Deputy Liquidator of First Keystone Risk Retention Group, The. ("First Keystone"). I was appointed to my position by the Liquidator, Raymond G. Farmer, Director of the South Carolina Department of Insurance.
 - I am over 21 years of age and suffer no legal disability.
- 3. By virtue of my appointment as Special Deputy Liquidator. I have been actively and personally involved in the liquidation of First Keystone at all times since it was placed into liquidation, including the matters addressed in this Affidavit. My responsibilities as the Special Deputy Liquidator include supervision and oversight of and direct involvement in the liquidation process. I am familiar with the claims process and with the claims that have been filed. Therefore, I have personal knowledge of the matters addressed in this Affidavit.
- 4. The claims process has included the following components, each and every one of which has been followed:
 - a. Notice of First Keystone's liquidation was given in accordance with S.C. Code Ann. § 38-27-410(a) (2015).

- b. In accordance with S.C. Code Ann. § 38-27-410(b) (2015), the notice specified that the last date to file a timely proof of claim with the Liquidator was February 28, 2015. Timely proofs of claim must be postmarked no later than 5:00 P.M. Mountain Standard Time, on such date.
- c. The Liquidator's Proof of Claim (POC) forms are in compliance with S.C. Code Ann. § 38-27-550(a) (2015) and provided notice thereof in accordance with S.C. Code Ann. § 38-27-410(b) (2015).
- d. As the duly-appointed Special Deputy Liquidator, I have considered each of the one-hundred and thirty-one (131) POCs subject to this Claims Report, in accordance with the requirements of the South Carolina Insurers Rehabilitation and Liquidation Act.
- e. I am administering the POC process. I contracted with Glynloen Consulting to assist me in the adjudication of claims under policies for losses incurred. I have charged Glynloen with the responsibility to make recommendations to the Liquidator as to the validity, valuation and priority of each POC. The Liquidator, and/or his duly appointed Special Deputy, then independently approves or denies Glynloen's recommendations in whole or in part and submits the same to this Court for approval.
- f. Each and every POC subject to this Claims Report contains the necessary claim file documentation for the Liquidator's recommendation thereon.
- g. To the extent this Claims Report includes claims that were denied in whole or in part, notice of such denial complying with S.C. Code Ann. § 38-27-580(a) (2015) was provided to the affected claimants and either no timely objection was made by

the affected claimants or the objection was resolved by mutual agreement.

- 5. I am submitting this Affidavit in support of Liquidator's Third Claims Report. Recommendation & Application for Order Approving Same & Recommendation To Bar Late Claims ("Report. Recommendation and Application"), which pertains to one-hundred and thirty-one (131) claims in priority class 2, as prescribed by S.C. Code Ann. §§ 38-27-610 & -620 (2015).
- 6. Between the entry of the Liquidation Order on October 21, 2014 and February 28, 2015. I caused to be issued approximately five thousand and seven hundred (5,700) Notices of Liquidation and Proof of Claim (POC) forms, together with instructions to policyholders, third-party claimants, and/or other potential claimants and creditors of First Keystone.
- 7. On November 3, 2014, I caused to be published Notice of the liquidation in the Philadelphia Daily News, a newspaper of countywide circulation in the County of Philadelphia, informing interested parties of the liquidation proceedings and including contact information and instructions for the timely filing of a claim.
- 8. On or before the Bar Date of February 28, 2015. I received one thousand six hundred and ninety-two (1.692) timely filed POCs, and one-hundred and twenty-four (124) fate-filed claims. Twenty-two (22) of the one-hundred and twenty-four (124) late-filed claims have now been considered timely filed, with one-hundred and two (102) pending further review.
- 9. Eight-hundred and thirty-one (831) claims have been previously adjudicated and approved by this Court in accordance with Orders dated March 24, 2017 and July 24, 2017.

 One-hundred and thirty-one (131) additional claims have now been adjudicated and are now the subject of this application. All remaining unadjudicated POCs are under evaluation.
- 10. Attached to this Application and incorporated by reference is Exhibit A which is the listing of the names and addresses of the one-hundred and thirty-one (131) claimants subject

to this application with a priority class 2 claim as defined in S.C. Code Ann. § 38-27-610(2) (2015), the number assigned to each of these Proof of Claims submitted and the claim valuation recommended and now proposed as the Liquidator's recommendation pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. § 38-27-620 (2015).

- 11. Actual distributions will be determined and made at the appropriate time in accordance with S.C. Code Ann. §§ 38-27-610 & -630 (2015).
- 12. I also recommend that, in order to prevent prejudice to the proceedings and the waste of assets and to ensure the orderly administration and timely closing of this liquidation that any POC filed on or after the date of the submission of this Application be deemed denied and forever barred.
- Application are not subject to modification. If any additional factors hereafter come to my attention which may require any modification, such as third-party payments or releases of any such claims. I will immediately notify the Liquidator, and he and/or I will promptly bring those matters to the attention of this Court in an application to modify such claims.


